

## Membership in the Deutsches Museum

The Deutsches Museum welcomes you to the Deutsches-Museum-Family.

### Members enjoy the following advantages:

- Your member card entitles you to free admission to exhibitions and events organized by the Deutsches Museum on the Museumsinsel, at the Flugwerft Schleissheim, the Verkehrszentrum on the Theresienhöhe, the Deutsches Museum Bonn, the Deutsches Museum Nürnberg and at the locomotive museum Lokwelt Freilassing.
- You are permitted to take with you – free of charge – one adult, plus two children (or all your own children) aged under 18.
- The museum magazine “Kultur & Technik” will be sent to you free of additional charge – if requested.

### Annual membership fees:

- The annual fee for the membership is currently € 102.
- The membership year begins and ends with the calendar year. The full annual fee is due regardless of when you join.
- As a goodwill gesture, if you apply for a membership for the coming year before end of the current year and pay the annual fee immediately, your member card will be valid from 1 December onwards – giving you one extra month of membership for free! The first issue of the magazine “Kultur & Technik” will be sent in the new year.
- Memberships in the Deutsches Museum run indefinitely with the calendar year and can be terminated in writing at any time, but not later than 31 October, with effect 31 December.

### Conditions of use of the member card:

- Passes are valid only in combination with an official photo ID. Members will not be granted free admission without adequate proof of identity.
- If a member abuses the terms under which his / her member card has been issued – for example, by handing it to an unentitled third party – the Deutsches Museum reserves the right to confiscate the pass, and to cancel the membership immediately without refunding the remainder of the annual fee.
- Please inform the member service immediately in case of loss or defect of the member card, and also of name changes. Replacement will be provided for a fee of € 5.
